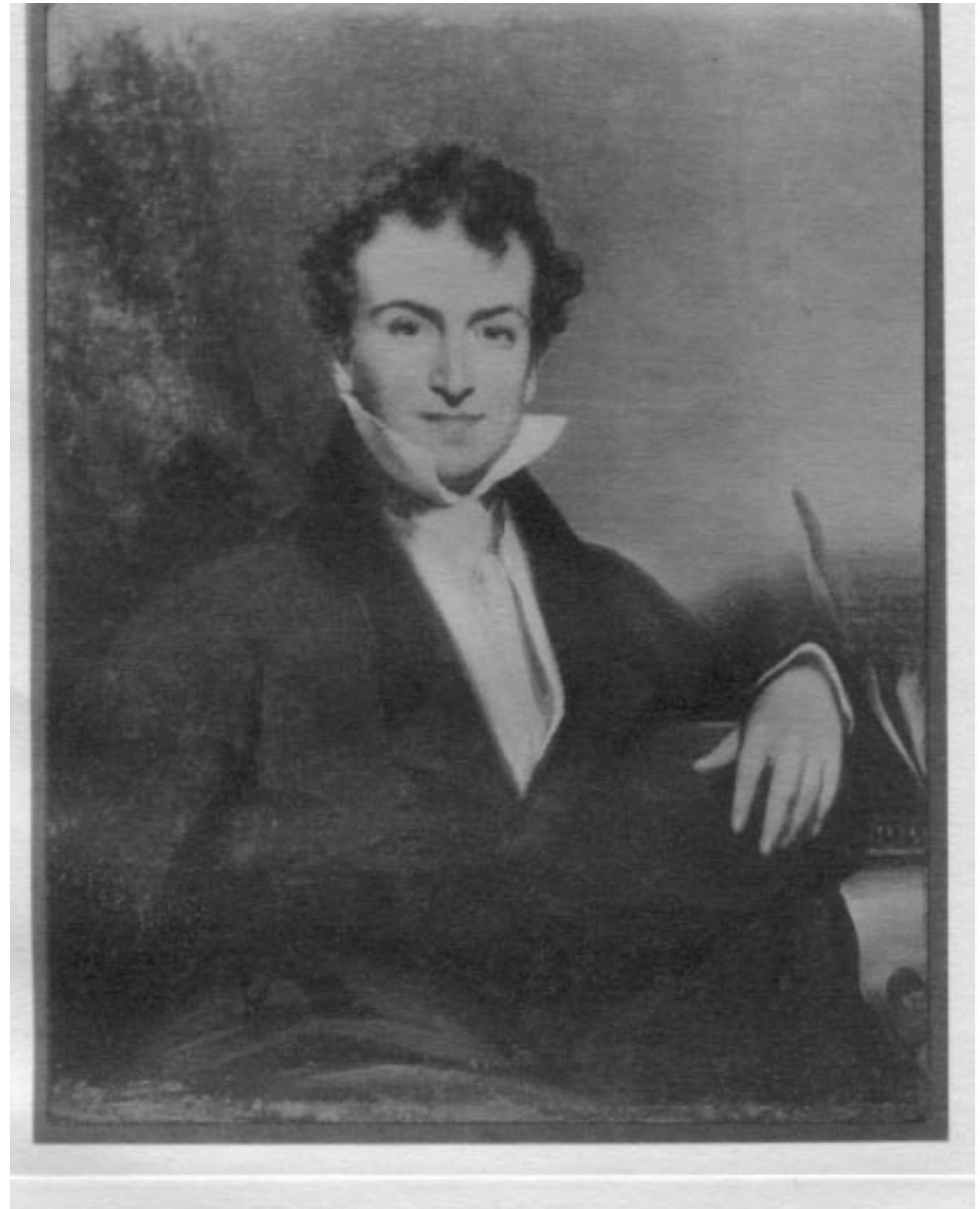

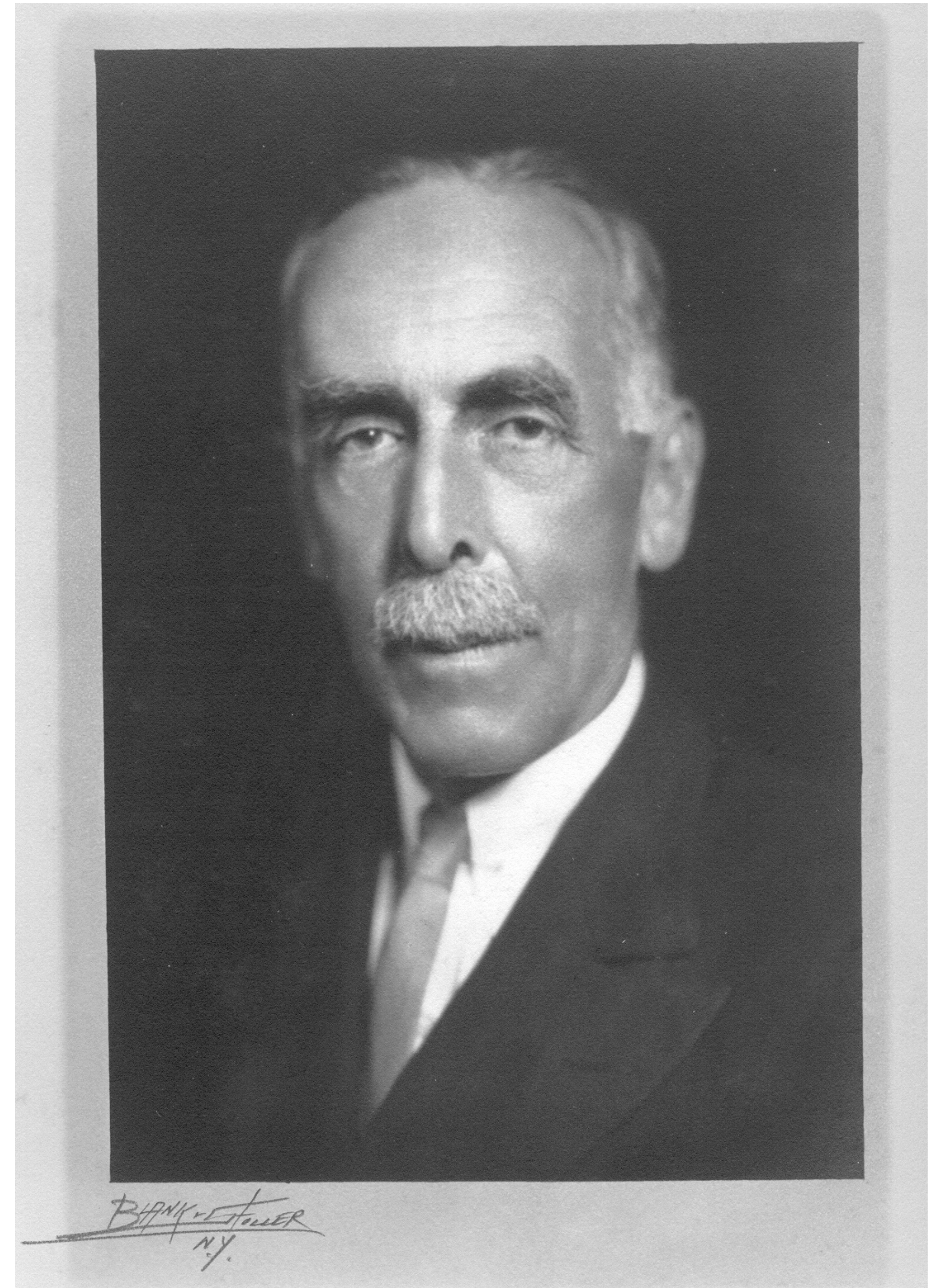
The wedding of Miss Marjorie Tilton, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Walter Henry Tilton of Whitney avenue, New Haven, and T. MacDonough Russell, jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. T. MacDonough Russell of Middletown, took place Wednesday afternoon at 1 o'clock in St. Stephen's Episcopal church, Ridgefield. The Rev. Dr. William Beardsley, rector of St. Thomas' church, New Haven, performed the ceremony, assisted by the Rev. M. E. Lusk, rector of St. Stephen's church. The bride, who was given in marriage by her father, was attended by Miss Margaret Russell, sister of the bridegroom, as maid of honor. The bridegroom's father, T. MacDonough Russell, was best man and two uncles, Jonathan Ingersoll of New York, and Samuel Russell, jr., of Ridgewood, were the ushers. The bride wore a robe of ivory bridal satin, cut on long severe lines, with long tight sleeves, and made with a peacock train. Her veil of tulle, a family heirloom, was trimmed with rosepoint lace, and fell from two large clusters of orange blossoms arranged low at the neckline. She carried a bouquet of calla lilies. The maid of honor wore shell pink French voile with a wide girdle of pink moire ribbon, and a pink horse-hair picture hat. Her arm bouquet was of garden flowers. At the wedding breakfast and reception which followed the ceremony in the garden of the rectory, about one hundred guests were present. The bridal party was assisted in receiving by the parents of the bride and bridegroom. Mrs. Tilton wore a gown of black and white chiffon with a foliage hat in violet shades and a corsage of small yellow rosebuds. Mrs. Russell was dressed in rose-colored French voile. She wore a picture hat in soft brown shades and a corsage of deep pink roses. Mr. and Mrs. Russell left by motor for New York, sailing Thurs-

day on the Coamo for Santo Domingo, their future home. Mr. Russell is manager of a large alfalfa ranch at Monte Cristi, known as the Celba ranch, which will be their home. Mr. Russell attended the Ridgefield school and Williams college, where he was a member of the class of 1922.
